## King Olav V Cancer Research Fund's Prize 2016

King Olav V Cancer Research Fund was established in 1992 in memory of King Olav V. Each year, the fund awards a prize to a cancer researcher, or group of researchers, who have contributed to the advancement of Norwegian cancer research. The prize is awarded by H.M. King Harald. Please see our webpages for additional information.

The prize is 1.000.000 NOK.

On behalf of King Olav V Cancer Research Fund, the Norwegian Cancer Society invites the nomination of candidates to receive the prize. Candidates may be individual researchers or a group of researchers. Evaluation of the nominated candidates will emphasize the following criteria:

- Whether the candidate(s) has a clear cancer relevance in central parts of his/her research career.
- Whether a majority of the research has been performed at a Norwegian research institution,
- Whether the researcher has achieved international recognition for his/her research,
- Whether the candidate(s) over time has contributed to building and strengthening the Norwegian research environment through his/her scientific commitment,
- Whether the scientific effort represents novel work within the field,
- To what extent the candidate(s) has disseminated his/her research results to the public

The Norwegian Cancer Society encourages the submission of nominations.

The nomination must be <u>written in English</u>, and contain a justified proposal for the candidate according to the criteria given above, and include the candidate's CV and full publication list.
