Governance to meet Global Development Challenges Bergen, June 23rd to July 4

GOVERNANCE is fundamental to the fabric of all societies and every aspect of social life. From political institutions, via international trade regimes and human rights treaties, to food regulations and anti-corruption measures, governance is about how we regulate our lives together, locally, nationally and globally; how we distribute resources, opportunities and burdens, and how we protect what we regard as valuable in our societies. Governance structures can create pathways to more fairness, human security, freedom and dignity – or it can do the opposite.

The Bergen Summer Research School invites PhD students and young researchers, to explore governance complex and interlinked challenges from different disciplines. The BSRS 2014 will be organized in **six parallel courses**. The courses will be bound together by joint lectures by high-profile keynote speakers. In addition to the doctoral courses, a set of plenary sessions and public meetings will reach out to the wider community.

PhD COURSES

1. Climate Change Governance: Governance structures addressing mitigation, adaptation and restitution in the face of a changing climate.
2. Differentiated Citizenship: Governing Populations Beyond Territorial State Borders.
3. Global Governance for Health
4. Marine Resources Governance
5. Studying Global Governance From Above and Below: Multilateral Organizations, Collective Action and the Politics of Development in the Global South
6. Uncertainty and quality in Sciences for Policy (methods)

The courses are aimed at PhD students and junior scholars, and are taught in English.

ECTS

Participants having fulfilled the course will receive 3 ECTS credits. Students that decide to submit a final paper will receive 10 ECTS if the paper is accepted.

TUITION FEES

NOK 4000. A limited number of full and partial scholarships are available to qualified students.
